WATER RESCUE AND RESPONSE TRAINING

The Washtenaw Area Mutual Aid Association is sponsoring a one-day “Awareness / Operations-Level Water Rescue and Response” training program this spring. This free 4-hour course stresses rescuer safety, scene assessment, hazard control, and patient removal without entering the water. The course will incorporate equipment typically carried by fire departments and will also familiarize the participants with the water rescue capabilities of the Washtenaw County Technical Rescue Swift Water Team. The course will include a classroom presentation as well as workshops along the Huron River. EMS Continuing Education credits are being applied for.

The class will start at Ann Arbor Fire Station 5, 1946 Beal, Ann Arbor, MI.
(Please park behind the station, or to the north of the station in lot NW42)

April 22, 2017 from 0800–1200 noon.

Class size is limited to 40 members.
